### John Kabuye Kalungi UPDATE Following Doris Kendi above..

The NERA Environment Sub Committee has identified a location in Nyayo where to keep the bags once aggregation is complete so you won't see the subsequent collections lined up like those there.

The Environment Sub Committee is overseeing the transformation of Nyayo from being a garbage disposing neighbourhood to a resource recovery neighbourhood as you can see with those bags which contain PET bottles that otherwise we discard as waste. You also notice that they do not have foul smell because they have been recovered from from source without contamination from the 30 Courts that are participating in the pilot phase while we get more bins for the remaining courts.

It is possible you may not know what is going on because your court is currently not participating but soon the bins will be brought to your courts and we will humbly ask you too to participate by putting your PET bottles in those mesh bins.

Moving forward, we intend to extend focus to other materials like other plastics, paper, glass organic (wet waste from kitchen) so that we live the model of future neighbourhoods others estate are still talking about. 8 CO
